

Building Permit Application Check Sheet

Solar Panels

The following items must be submitted in order to obtain a Building Permit for Solar Panels: (Occasionally if there are unusual circumstances additional information may be required.)

Incomplete Applications will not be processed until all items have been received.

	Completed "BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION INFORMATION" form
	3 copies of a site plan and equipment layout: For Ground Mounted Arrays - Draw proposed Solar Panels on the survey or site plan with dimensions and show property lines, setbacks, accessory buildings, easements, walkways and a north arrow.
	3 complete sets of working plans, to include North Arrow – System Overview Footing and post details - show depth of post or footing. (if ground mounted) Note: Soil test information is required unless the load on supports is 1000 lbs./sq. ft. or less. Total System Size noted on plans Solar Module Model, Rating, Information String Size Racking System Pitch of Array Inverter Model Array Azimuth Ridge Height Interconnecting Voltage Required signage Compliance with 2020 FCNYS SECTION 1204 (this includes BCNYS or RCNYS and NFPA 70)
	Amherst Fire Safety Division "PV Installation – Fire Safety Information" form
	3 copies of the Wiring Diagram
	3 complete sets of product information (cut sheets), to include: _ Inverter Information _ Panel Information _ Fastener/Deck Information
	Energy Storage System (if applicable) – 3 complete sets of plans/cut sheets to include information for: Battery storage Vehicle impact protection plan Heat detector Room rating (walls and ceiling)
	Provide structural analysis under seal and signature from Engineer/Architect indicating the applicable code. This shall include information on the Basic Wind Speeds and Fastener Loads. If structural modifications are required provide appropriate plans. <i>The analysis shall have an original stamp and signature</i> .
	Filing Fee is equal to ½ the Building Permit Fee and Electrical Fee
*Note:	All electrical work performed within the Town of Amherst must have a permit and must be inspected, regardless of who

Work shall not begin until a Building Permit has been issued!
