All plans for new or major changes in commercial and/or industrial buildings, structures or uses or mechanical equipment must contain a certification by a New York State licensed engineer or architect that the mechanical plans meet all the provisions of the currently applicable Building Code 2020 Edition of New York State Codes.

All plans for buildings, structures, alterations or equipment subject to the 2020 Energy Conservation Construction Code must be certified by a licensed professional that the plans were prepared by him and are in compliance with the 2020 NYS ECCC.

A permit to build from the NYS Dept. of Environmental Conservation if the parcel contains a designated wetland.

Designation of a New York State licensed Professional Engineer or Architect to oversee construction and provide certain certifications to the Commissioner of Building prior to the issuance of a certificate of occupancy on complex or specialized buildings, structures or equipment installations.

The property owner or their agent has been advised that it is their responsibility for compliance with the NYS Labor Department Industrial Code Rule 56 - ASBESTOS.

Any additional information or document required by the Commissioner of Building as a result of new codes, ordinances, laws, rules or regulations, variance granted, site plan approvals, rezoning or conditions peculiar to the given parcel or lot.
