

RESCINDING LOCAL DECLARATION OF "A STATE OF EMERGENCY"

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020 at approximately 1200 hours, I, Brian J. Kulpa, Supervisor of the Town of Amherst, having determined there was an imminent threat to life and property associated with COVID-19 Global Pandemic declared a State of Emergency in the Town of Amherst, pursuant to Section 24, of the New York State Executive Law, Article 2B, and;

WHEREAS, it appears that the existence of that local emergency has ceased to exist and protection is no longer essential;

Now, therefore, I, Brian J. Kulpa, Supervisor of the Town of Amherst, pursuant to Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, Article 2B, do hereby rescind the existing local State of Emergency effective at 1200 hours on this 24th day of June, 2021.
