**A:** Routes for emergency vehicles will be maintained and open during construction.


**Q: How will this affect access and deliveries to local businesses?**

## Project Overview

The project proposes to realign both legs of Hopkins Road at the intersection of Millersport Highway to eliminate the skewed approaches. All four legs of the intersection will be widened to add dedicated left turn lanes, and a new three-color traffic signal will be installed. Additionally, the project will include coordination of traffic signals on Millersport Highway between Crosspoint Parkway and the end of Interstate 990.

Roadside ditches and drainage pipes will be re-established to accommodate the widening. Pavement will be restored to good condition.

## What Will the Project Accomplish?

The project aims to improve highway operation, enhance safety and reduce the crash rate at the intersection of Millersport Highway and Hopkins Road. Traffic signal coordination along Millersport Highway will improve traffic flow along the corridor.

## Minimizing Construction Impacts

Two-way traffic will be maintained, and no off-site detours are necessary.

Nighttime construction is not planned due to the proximity to residential homes as well as the ability to maintain traffic with acceptable delays during daylight hours.
