



Buffalo Niagara International Airport construction this summer

Buffalo Niagara International Airport (BNIA) announces that the second and final phase of the full reconstruction of the main runway will take place this summer. As with the first phase last summer, a temporary shift in air traffic patterns will result. BNIA said in a statement: “We are grateful for the continued patience of our neighbors as we make critical investments in BNIA, which generates approximately \$1.7 billion in annual economic activity, supports nearly 12,000 jobs and generates \$127 million in annual state and local tax contributions.”

This shift in air traffic patterns is temporary. Additionally, in recent days BNIA has worked with its contractors to minimize the extent and duration of the closure and the resultant traffic pattern shift to the greatest extent possible.

This table shows the current closure schedule for the main runway:

June 1 and June 2 only	Overnight closure only (9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.)
July	Overnight closure only (9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.)
August and September	Full 24/7 closure
October	Overnight closure only (9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.)

“Again, we are grateful for the patience of the communities we serve as we make this significant and necessary infrastructure investment. This is the first full reconstruction of BNIA’s main runway since 1948.” – BNIA statement
