# ORDER CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING TO BE HELD ON AUGUST 19, 2024

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Amherst, in the County of Erie, New York (the "Town") has caused the Town to prepare several maps, plans and reports for the proposed extensions of the Consolidated Lighting District in the Town, pursuant to Article 12-A of the Town Law (the "Extensions"); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board, as lead agency, has given due consideration to the impact that the Extensions may have on the environment, and the Town Board and the Town have

complied in every respect with all applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations regarding environmental matters, including compliance with the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), comprising Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law and, in connection therewith, the Town Board has determined that the proposed action is a Type II action for SEQRA purposes and will not have a significant effect on the environment and a Negative Declaration has been issued; and

WHEREAS, the properties to be included in the Extensions are listed on the Town's website at <a href="www.amherst.ny.us">www.amherst.ny.us</a> and on file with the office of the Town Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Town will separately notify each of the properties affected by the proposed Extensions; and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount proposed to be expended by the Town for the Extensions is the sum of zero dollars (\$0.00) as there is no cost for the Extensions; and

WHEREAS, the annual estimated cost of providing street lighting services within the Extensions for a \$300,000 Property at 100% Equalization is \$118.85; and

WHEREAS, since there will be no capital cost to the Town for the Extensions, no financing will be employed and it is therefore not necessary to obtain the approval of the New York State Comptroller's Office.

## NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

ORDERED, that a meeting of the Town Board of the Town be held at the Town Hall, 5583 Main Street, Williamsville, New York, on the 19th day of August, 2024 at 7:00 P.M. (Prevailing Time) to consider said Extensions and to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof

concerning the same and for such other action on the part of the Town Board with relation thereto as may be required by law; and be it,

FURTHER ORDERED, that the Town Clerk publish at least once in the "Amherst Bee," hereby designated as the official newspaper of the Town for such publication, post on the sign board of the Town maintained pursuant to subdivision 6 of Section 30 of the Town Law, post to the Town's website at <a href="https://www.amherst.ny.us">www.amherst.ny.us</a>, and mail to the properties located in the Extensions, the Order Calling A Public Hearing, the first publication thereof, posting and mailing to be not less than ten (10) nor more than twenty (20) days before the date of such public hearing.
