**"Let's Do Lunch with Joel Dombrowski."**

**Speaker:** Joel Dombrowski will present a 1 hour discussion on "Lawless Buffalo", a look at Buffalo's rough days as it emerged from a frontier village to become the 8th largest city in the US. The presentation focuses on Buffalo's notorious waterfront, immigration and canal days. After Joel Dombrowski had a career in Broadcast Journalism, he began applying his storytelling skills to his lifelong passion-- Buffalo's history. He owns and operates Buffalo Double Decker Bus, which provides humorous, historical tours of the city. Trip Advisor calls his tours "The #1 Thing to do in Buffalo."
